

A case report: Anterior restoration in aesthetic zone combined soft tissue augmentation with PFT technique.

Abstract:

A 32 year-old female patient have finished orthodontic treatment and refer for rehabilitation of anterior teeth. She was suffered from ill-fitted crown and gingival recession. Performing the root coverage and papilla augmentation surgery resolved the problem of soft tissue deficiency first. By using the novel PFT technique and under the microscope, achieve papilla augmentation and root coverage at the same time is possible. After 6 months healing, finishing the veneers and crown under the microscope for improving the appearance.

Microscope-assisted periodontal and prosthodontal treatment can improve the quality and level very well nowadays.
