

JAMD Certified Physician System Regulations

【Chapter 1 General rules】

Article 1. This system aims to contribute to the health and welfare of the people by maintaining and improving the advanced level of microscopic dentistry by dentists with expert knowledge and clinical skills and experience of microscopic dental medicine.

Article 2. In order to achieve the purpose of the preceding article, the Japan Association of Microscopic Dentistry (hereinafter referred to as "the Association") has established a system of a Japanese Association of Microscopic Dentistry Certification (hereinafter referred to as "Certified Physician") and conduct business as follows.

【Chapter 2 Qualifications of Applicant for Certified Physician】

Article 3 Persons who can apply for Certified Physician need to satisfy all of the following items.

1. Have a Japanese dental physician's license.
2. Be a member of the Association at the time of applying for a Certified Physician.
3. To satisfy the conditions listed in each issue of the Certified Physician of Article 5.

【Chapter 3 Basic conditions of Certified Physician】

Article 4 The Certified Physician will acquire high medical skills for diagnosis, prevention and treatment in the field of microscopic dentistry and the ability to give appropriate instructions in response to requests from other clinical departments dental physician or doctors.

Article 5 The Certified Physician shall satisfy all of the following items.

1. Attend academic conferences.
2. Provide diagnosis, prevention and treatment of areas related to microscopic dentistry.
3. Further details to be specified separately.

Article 6. Other persons who have been specifically acknowledged by the Association.

【Chapter 4: Applying to become a Certified Physician】

Article 7. A Certification Committee shall be established to review the qualifications of applicants.

Article 8. Applicants for Certified Physician shall submit applications to the Association together with application fee specified separately.

[Chapter 5. The Certification Committee]

Article 9. The Certification Committee consists of about ten members.

1. Committee members shall be nominated by the president from the Association members and approved by the board.
2. The term of office of the committee shall be two years, and the reappointment is not prohibited.
3. One chairperson and one vice chairman are appointed by the president.

Article 10. The Certification Committee shall be established with the attendance of more than one third of the committee members.

1. Acceptance of a Certified Physician is decided by a majority of committee members excluding the chairperson, and in the case of an equal number of votes, it is decided by the chairperson. Results will be reported to the Board.
2. The Certification Committee will be held as needed.

【Chapter 6 Audit Method】

Article 11. The Certified Physician is judged comprehensively based on qualification screening and document examination by the Certification Committee, and it is approved by the executive board based on the above report.

Article 12. Appraisal of document will be carried out at the time of accreditation of Certified Physician.

1. The Certification Committee will judge the qualification based on the result of the preceding Article 11.

2. The Board of Directors will make their certification.

Article 13. A person who receives accreditation must apply for registration with a registration fee.

Article 14. The Association confirms the preceding paragraph and makes registration based on the application.

1. The Association will issue certificates and report at academic journals and academic congress.

Article 15. The certificate shall be issued after the registration fee has been paid and the application for registration is submitted.

【Chapter 7. Registration of Certified Physician】

Article 16. The Certified Physician applicants who have passed the examination by the Certification Committee shall pay the registration fee.

Article 17. The Association confirms the preceding paragraph, delivers the certificate, and reports at the JAMD Journal and to the general assembly.

[Chapter 8 Renewal of Certification]

Article 18. Certified Physicians must renew their certification every five years, except for those who have been specially recognized by the Association.

Article 19. In renewing the certification of a Certified Physician, the provisions separately prescribed shall be satisfied during the certification period of 5 years.

Article 20. If you are 63 years of age or older at the time of renewal and also meet the necessary requirements, you can apply for a lifetime Certified Physician designation by submitting a Lifetime Renewal application (Form 8). However, even if you are 63 years of age or older and apply for a Certified Physician for the first time, you need to apply under the usual certification application procedures.

【Chapter 9 Loss of Qualification】

Article 21. When the Certified Physician falls under one of the following items, he / she loses his / her qualification through the discussion of the Certification Committee.

1. When the successful applicant declines the qualification.
2. When the successful applicant loses their Japanese dental practitioner's license.
3. When the successful applicant loses his JAMD membership.
4. When the successful applicant does not apply for certification renewal.
5. When the Certification Committee deems it unsuitable that the successful applicant continues as a Certified Physician.

Article 22. Even if the successful applicant loses the Certified Physician status, he/she can apply for the Certified Physician status again if the reason for the loss is overcome.

【Chapter 10 Supplementary Procedure】

Article 23. Any person who has an objection on the decision of the Certification Committee may file a request to the Chairman.

[Supplementary Provisions]

This rule shall come into force as from June 30, 2009.

Article 9. The Certification Committee consists of under 10 members.

Revision- The Certification Committee consists of about ten members.

Article 10. The Certification Committee shall be established with the attendance of a majority of committee members.

Revision- The Certification Committee shall be established with the attendance of more than one third of the committee members.

Japan Association of Microscopic Dentistry Certified Physician System Rules

(Established June 30, 2009)

Article 1. Matters stipulated for the Regulation of the Certified Physician System of the Japanese Association of Microscopic Dentistry (hereinafter referred to as "Rules") shall be administered in accordance with these rules.

Article 2. The basic conditions of application for a Certified Physician under Article 5 of the regulations shall be as follows.

1. As a general rule, an applicant must have a membership history of 3 years or more at the time of application.

2. A letter of recommendation from two directors / councilors is required (proof that an applicant has experience giving dental treatments using a microscope).

3. Submit one video-recorded clinical case at the time of application and answer questions about the case. The Society presents the reference example to HP.

4. Paper examination is given.

Article 3. The Certified Physician admitted specifically by the Association of Article 6 shall be a member that is significantly contributing to the Association and approved by the executive board.

Article 4. Any person who fulfills Article 3 of the certification and applies for the qualifications of the Certified Physician shall submit to the Certification Committee with the application fee attached to the documents specified in the following items.

(Each format is available on our website)

1. Certified Physician application form (Form 1)

2. Resume (Form 2)

3. A copy of dentistry license.

4. Council recommendation letter (Form 3)

5. Video-recorded Case (CD-R or DVD)

6. Agreement on the use of clinical images (Form 4)

Article 5. The fees specified in Articles 8, 13, and Article 9 of the Regulations shall be set forth in the following items.

1. Certification application fee: 20,000 yen.

2. Registration fee: 10,000 yen.

3. Renewal fee: 20,000 yen.

Article 6. The immediate payment application fee prescribed in the preceding article, registration fee, renewal fee shall not be refunded for any reason.

Article 7. In principle, successful applicants must post a case report to "JAMD Electronic Journal". (Instructions are determined separately)

Article 8. In renewing as a Certified Physician, the following conditions shall be satisfied within the five years prior to renewal.

1. Attendance at an Annual Convention (Attaching a copy of participation certificate etc. to prove attendance.

Japan Association of Microscopic Dentistry Annual Convention-	4 credits
Season Seminar (Former case study meeting)	2 credits
Satellite Seminar	2 credits
Members ' Seminar-	2 units
JAMD-Related Conference	1 unit

However, for long-term overseas visitors, attendance at international academic meetings can be accepted as a unit. Attendance units for academic conferences within the past 5 years are included at the time of application. Attendance at an academic event, etc. shall be proved by a participation certificate or a certificate of completion.

2. Presentation of areas related to microscopic dentistry.

1) Publications

(1) "JAMD Journal"	as the lead author-	6 units
(2) "JAMD Journal"	co-authors other than the lead author	3 units.
(3) Journal of related academic societies	lead author-	4 units
(4) Journal of related academic societies	co-authors other than the lead author	2 units.

2) Presentations for Conferences

(1)JAMD Annual Convention	leading speaker	6 units
(2) JAMD Annual Convention	supporting speaker-	3 units.
(3) Season Seminar (Former case study meeting)	Leader	3 units
(4) Satellite Seminar	Speaker (instructor)	6 units.
(5) Related academic societies conference	speaker	3 units
(6) Related academic societies conference	supporting speaker	1 units
(7) Lectures and others approved by the Certification	Committee (instructor)-	4 units

"Presentation of areas related to microscopic dental medicine" means publications related to microscopic dental medicine in academic meetings (including international societies) or publications (including international journals) approved by the Certification Committee and presentations to a conference. In addition, academic meetings recognized by the Certification Committee, in principle, refer to the specialized subcommittee of the JAMD. Also, the publications

approved by the Certification Committee, in principle, refer to the same journal of the Association, but some dental-related magazines may be admitted in some cases. The international academic conference and international journals will be decided by the Certification Committee.

3. The certification units required for renewal shall be 12 units or more in 5 years.

Article 9. A person who intends to renew as a Certified Physician shall submit to the Association a renewal application by the renewal application form (Form 5, 6) with the renewal fee. Certified Physician renewal applications shall be made from one year to six months before the expiration date.

Article 10. Any person who does not require the Certified Physician renewal under Article 18 of the regulations shall be those who are admitted specifically by the Association in Article 6 of the regulations and the person admitted by the Board of Directors.

Article 11. In the implementation and operation of this system, finance is handled by a special account separate from the Association accounts.

Article 12. With regard to the amendment of these bylaws, approval from the Certification Committee and Board of Directors is required.

【Supplementary Provisions】

This detailed regulation shall come into force as from June 30, 2009.

Article 8. Revisions are made for attendance and presentation seminar etc., name and unit number as well as explanatory text.
